3. Approval of minutes of September 21, 2000 Policy Committee meeting.

Discussion pursued about adding representatives from the MPO member organizations. Mr. Rhodes moved with Mr. Thibodeaux's second to add Mr. Black to the TAC. No opposition to motion, motion PASSED.
