



Local Road Safety Plans

A Local Road Safety Plan (LRSP) provides a framework to identify, analyze, and prioritize roadway safety improvements on local roads

THE LRSP DEVELOPMENT PROCESS

1. Establish Leadership
2. Analyze Safety Data
3. Determine Emphasis Areas
4. Identify Strategies
5. Prioritize and Incorporate Strategies
6. Evaluate and Update


Development of These Plans Involves ...

- Meeting with Parish Engineers, Public Works and Elected Officials to review the data and solicit recommendations for project development
- Integration with existing plans
- Local jurisdictional council action to adopt the plan
