ARC of St Mary: There was no update.

<u>Assumption ARC:</u> S. Olivo relayed they have received two new buses. They are still having AC problems. The 2018 and 2019 models have gone out.

SED#1: M. Danos relayed they are having some AC issues and electrical problems. They are waiting on new vehicles.

<u>Terrebonne COA:</u> J. Fitch relayed they have received three new buses.

Terrebonne ARC: T. Bergeron discussed they are still trying to hire more staff.

Lafourche ARC: A. Webb discussed they still have a driver shortage.

<u>Lafourche COA:</u> M. Collins relayed they are having issues hiring, AC complications, and one of their vehicles' engines went out.

Good Earth Transit: G. Vaughn relayed they are still short staffed. Their shuttle buses have had some AC problems.

<u>Assumption COA:</u> A. Authement relayed they are having some AC and lift issues. Their biggest issue is hiring more drivers.

<u>St. James Parish Government</u>: S. Jasmin relayed they have received nine buses. They are not able to keep drivers. M. Moses relayed that the molding on a few of the buses is coming loose.

Some members claimed that the drivers are disconcerted by the responsibilities of the job that are more than just opening and closing the door. P. Gordon wanted to know if the state would have a set salary for the position.
